PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Understanding and speaking English are required for success and promotion in any job and for personal development.

ESL students benefit from being able to take advantage of education and training opportunities, which lead to employment, promotion or a higher salary. All of these benefit families by improving their opportunities and increasing their self-confidence.

COURSE OUTLINE

■ BEGINNER LEVEL (1)

Private School EAP Level One introduces students to the English competencies suitable for instruction in an academic environment. This course is appropriate for those in a high beginner level. The books correspond to an A2-to A2+ on the Common European Framework of Reference of CEFR (or an approximate equivalent of 3.0 on the IELTS). The course is 300 hrs long. It runs full-time from 12 weeks, 25 hours a week, 5 hours a day

■ PRE-INTERMEDIATE LEVEL (2)

Private School EAP Level Two continues to develop English competencies suitable for instruction in an academic environment. This course is appropriate for those in a low intermediate level. The books correspond to an A2+ to B1– on the common European Framework of Reference or CEFR (or an approximate equivalent of 3.0 to 4.5 on the IELTS). The course is 300 hours long. It runs full-time for 12 weeks, 25 hours a week, 5 hours a day.

■ INTERMEDIATE LEVEL (3)

Private School EAP Level Three continues to develop English competencies suitable for instruction in academic environment. This course is appropriate for those in an intermediate level. The books correspond to a B1– to B1+ on the Common European Framework of Reference of CEFR (or an approximate equivalent of 3.5 to 4.5 on the IELTS). The course is 300 long. It runs full-time for 12 weeks, 25 hours a week, 5 hours a day

■ HIGH INTERMEDIATE LEVEL (4/5)

Private School High Intermediate allows students to further develop the complex and sophisticated English language skills required for academic success in an English speaking college or university. The course is for participants who are at a high intermediate level of English language proficiency or a B1+ to B2– level on the Common European Framework of Reference (CEFR). This is the equivalent of between a 5.0 and 6.5 on the IELTS. In this course students learn to complete the following academic language tasks.
