ALBERTA HCA PROGRAM OVERVIEW

Health Care Aides work with residents of all ages in a variety of settings such as the hospitals, retirement homes, long term facilities, assisted living centers, other private health care and community agencies.

The Alberta HCA Program can be completed in five (5) months and is delivered as a full time and part time education.

The Alberta HCA Program prepares the student to take on the roles and responsibilities of a HCA within the scope of practice. Upon completion of the program, the student will be able to demonstrate and perform the following daily living tasks with confidence and efficiency: Taking vital signs, bathing patients, making beds, assisting with dressing and grooming, changing simple dressings (superficial wounds), assisting with feeding and assisting with medication administration.
