#### **ELIGIBILITY AND ASSESSMENT**

MTG Healthcare Academy acknowledges assessment done by an accredited company or institution such as international Qualifications assessment services (IQAS) for Alberta, International Credential Evaluation Services (ICES) for British Columbia and World Education Services (WES) for Ontario.

Depending on the result of the evaluation of the assessment, MTG Healthcare Academy will then determine the eligibility of the applicant to enroll in the program or course of interest.

Furthermore, applicants must be 18 years and older and must meet the admission requirements for the program to which they are applying. It is encouraged for the applicants to apply early as approval or study permit may take several months to obtain.

International student must be a graduate of a 4-year program and/or Grade 12 equivalent and must submit to the Office of the Registrar the following documents for further assessment, evaluation and authentication or as per recommendation from the assessment board

# **ENGLISH REQUIREMENTS**

From a country where the language of instruction is not English will need to provide an English Language Proficiency.

### **IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS**

All students enrolled for the HCA program must provide their updated immunization record prior to starting practicum.
